



When and how do we cancel a game for weather?

If the Home coach determines that the fields are unplayable, the decision to cancel the game must be made by 7am on the day of the game. This early decision allows all parties to be contacted.

After that point, only the referee may cancel or delay the match due to weather or field conditions at game time.

If a game is cancelled:

Classic Games: The Home Coach or Manager should notify Linda Huttenhoff (lhuttenhoff@maysa.org or 276-9030) as soon as possible about the cancellation, so that she may notify the referees. The Home Coach or Manager must also contact the Away team's Coach or Manager.

Rec Games: The Home Coach or Manager is responsible for contacting ALL referees. The Home Coach must also contact the Away team's Coach or Manager as soon as possible.

NEW- U13+ Rec Games: Contact your Club's referee assigner to get referee names and numbers, if the Club has assigned your referees.

Once the game has started, the decision to stop play due to weather rests solely with the referee. If the game is called before halftime, it must be replayed. If the game is called at halftime or any point thereafter, the game is considered a complete game and the final score stands.

Please note that MAYSA does not cancel games for weather. MAYSA reserves the right to cancel games at Reddan Soccer Park due to field conditions.
